

MEMBERS CODE OF CONDUCTS

ALL MEMBERS AGREE TO

- Contribute an annual membership fee at the point of registration
- Contribute 10 monthly payments from August to May as set out by the club
- Abide by the clubs Code of Conducts at all times
- Never use inappropriate, foul or abusive language
- Always show respect to coaches, players & spectators from other clubs
- Respect all match officials, at all times
- Encourage and praise players from both teams
- Avoid unruly or disruptive behaviour at **ALL** times
- Allow the coach to coach, do **NOT** coach your child from the side line

PARENTS, GUARDIANS AND FAMILY MEMBERS HAVE A DUTY TO

- Ensure their child arrives on time for all club related activities
- Inform the coach at the earliest opportunity their child is unable to attend training or matches
- Make suitable arrangements to collect their child after all club activities
- Ensure club subscriptions are paid on a monthly basis
- Look after all team kit, returning all team kit at the end of the season
- Return all club kit at the end of the season or within 7 days of leaving the club

THE CLUB WILL NOT TOLERATE

- The use of inappropriate, racist and/or foul language or abuse in any form
- Anyone being under the influence of drugs or alcohol
- Unauthorised infringements to the field of play
- Unruly or disruptive behaviour at coaching sessions or matches
- Abuse of match officials, verbal or physical

DISCLAIMER

The members Code of Conduct, covers all playing members and all spectators of the club. It applies to all official club activities regardless of location.

Any person found to be in breach of the clubs Code of Conduct will have their membership (or that of their child) reviewed by the clubs executive committee

The club runs a 24 hour NON contact policy:

If a parent/guardian would like to discuss a matter with the coach of their child's team after training or a match, they must wait 24 hours before talking to the coach.
